Tahmoor Coking Coal is an underground coal mining operation situated in the Southern Highlands Region of NSW, located just south of the Tahmoor township and approximately 80km south west of Sydney. Tahmoor Coking Coal has been in operation since 1980, and since April 2018 have been owned and operated by SIMEC Mining, a member of the GFG Alliance.

Managing mining subsidence on the Main Southern Railway

Tahmoor Coal has been mining under the Main Southern Railway for over 15 years with a record of managing rail subsidence with *no delays* to rail traffic.

- Pre-mining infrastructure preparation
